



A few essential items to have on hand in your vehicle when traveling

- Medical Kit with at least two tourniquets
- Seat belt cutter
- Window/ glass breaker
- Food- non-perishable
- Water- at least a gallon
- Comfortable shoes for walking
- Rain gear
- Other clothes appropriate for the weather
- Sun screen and insect repellent
- Fix-a-flat
- Tire repair kit
- Portable phone charger or solar charger
- Fire starter
- Flares or reflective traffic triangles
- Flashlight
- Regular or emergency blanket
- Pepper spray

What to do if you are in or at the scene of an accident

- Move car to a safe area if possible- if it won't move, turn on hazard lights
- Stop vehicle and get out if safe to do so
- Check everyone involved for injuries- call 911 if anyone is injured
- Move to the sidewalk or shoulder away from vehicle
- Call Police- do not admit guilt or cast blame on others
- Gather info from other driver- name, address, phone number, license plate number and insurance details
- Gather info from witnesses
- Document the scene- take photos and write notes about what happened.
